10. (e) REGISTRATION OF PLAYERS

All players listed in the teams as submitted by clubs must play in the grade and section as graded by the Match Committee. No listed player will be permitted to play in a lower grade, or section within the grade.

11. ELIGIBILITY

(e) No player may play in the final series unless they shall have played **three** home and away matches. These matches can have been played in a lower graded team for the same club in the same competition. For Juniors, date of birth must also have been provided.

24. FINALS SERIES

(j) **The Committee** of Management has the right to vary the finals format and the scheduled date, time, and venue for any matches, in order to ensure a satisfactory completion of the season. Should the home courts, and their outside venue, be unavailable for any reason, the Match Committee, where possible, will move the match to the venue of the opposition team.

Finals Procedures

11. It is also noted that, in JUNIOR FINAL SERIES MATCHES, the home Club is to provide a SENIOR MEMBER to act as a SUPERVISOR AND REFEREE. This applies equally to those situations where the home Club is using another club's courts for the convening of the match. The Venue Supervisor must wear the orange Waverley Supervisor vest for the duration of the match and be visible, and available, to all participants.

Duties of the Venue Supervisor

b. The Venue Supervisor must introduce themselves to visiting clubs prior to the match commencing, and the orange Venue Supervisor vest must be worn for the duration of all matches at each home venue used by a club.
